What is illegal?

alcohol



alcohol is only legal in certain circumstances and factors include:

- your age
- quantity
- venue
- time of day

"party drugs" include MDMA, cocaine, ketamine, meth, ICE, LSD (acid)

heroin, cannabis, magic mushrooms and other hallucinogens

illegal drugs often contain additives which do harm and can kill you:

- battery acid
- drain cleaner
- Panadol

too much of this over-the-counter drug can kill

Prescription medications (or "behind-the-counter drugs") are only for the person listed on the prescription

Overdose. Addiction. Damaged mental health.

The law aims to keep you safe. That's why some drugs are illegal or allowed only under medical treatment

you can buy alcohol for yourself or another person who is also at least 18 years old.

Party Safe

You can drink at a private party at someone's house if:

- permission from parent/guardian
- responsible adults supervising party
- amount of alcohol is reasonable
- food and non-alcoholic drinks also available
