Children should be safe.



Child Safety is a government service.



People can tell Child Safety if they think a kid is not safe.



Some people like teachers and nurses need to tell Child Safety if they are worried a kid is not safe.



Child Safety workers will help the family to make a kid safe.



Sometimes Child Safety need to find a new home for a kid.



The new home might be with other family or foster carers.



The kid may live in a new home for a long time.



A court decides what is best to keep a child safe.



Lawyers help parents and kids at court.



Kids will have their own separate lawyer.



The court is a helping court and not about punishment.



Anyone can talk to a lawyer for free at Tasmania Legal Aid.
